General Guidelines:

- The dance is for current McClure students only. Students from other schools are not allowed to attend.
- There will be special decorations and snack foods provided to make this a very special evening.
- Dinner **will not** be served.
- Tickets will be sold for this event for \$10.00, and a ticket must be purchased for a student to attend. (If an 8th Grade PTSA bundle was purchased at the beginning of the school year, a ticket has been credited to the 8th grade student.)
- Transportation should occur in normal fashion. Limousines **are not** allowed.
- Parents of eighth grade students will not be permitted to chaperone the dance.

8th Grade Dance Dress Code:

Ladies:

- May wear short or long dresses that are appropriate.
- All dresses should be at least as long as the student's longest fingertip as school dress code requires.
- Spaghetti straps on dresses are acceptable.
- Strapless dresses are not allowed.
- Dresses with slits that are higher than fingertip length are not allowed.
- Backless dresses are not allowed.

Gentlemen:

- Should wear dress pants or khakis with a shirt and tie. Jackets may be worn but are not required.
- Tuxedos and shorts are not allowed.
